Scenic Acres Housing Market this year we have seen the average home price in the community increase by 6.5%. This is well above the Calgary Real Estate boards forecast of 1.5%. Buyer's are feeling bullish and the Crowchild corridor is a very popular destination for them. Over 80% of community home sales this year are under \$650,000 and our starting price for single family homes is \$450,000 while town homes start at \$370,000. The year started with record low inventory levels which remained the case up until early June at which point

home inventories increased to a balanced level by mid July. Since mid July we have seen sales in some prices ranges slow causing an inventory build up at those price points.

Predictions for the remainder of the year are varied some feel we are going to level while others see prices backing down from the spring highs. I'm leaning towards a balanced market. We are all fortunate to live here.
